

BOARD BRIEFS AUGUST 20 2013

Superintendent's Report/Presentations

- District Energy Efficiency Coordinator Victoria Tarentino updated the Board on the district's energy initiatives and resultant cost savings.
- Superintendent Barbara Sargent reported on the following:
 - Newly hired teachers are attending New Staff Orientation this week.
 - * Student placement information for Grades K-5 students is now available through the Genesis student information system. Middle school schedules will be ready on Monday, August 26.
 - * Staff returns on Tuesday, September 3; open houses will be held on Friday, September 6.
 - * Construction at TBS and WHS is concluding; all schools will be ready for students on September 9. Window replacement at RMS will begin later this month.
 - * Positive feedback was shared about the work done by the six student technicians this summer.

Finance/Facilities

- The donation of a composter from Envirocycle was accepted for TBS.
- ♦ A resolution for the disposal of two surplus school buses via online auction was authorized.
- An inter-local agreement with the Township of Readington was approved to provide security services from September 1 through December 31, 2013.
- ♦ Bus routes were approved for the 2013-14 school year.

Education/Technology

- ♦ Field trips were approved for the 2013-14 school year.
- Novels were approved for various grade levels.
- ◆ Curricula were approved for Writer's Workshop (Gr. K-8), Mandarin (Gr. 6-7), and Ethics/Leadership/Finance Cycle (Gr. 6-8).
- Submission of the FY2014 NCLB grant application was approved.

Personnel

- Substitutes were approved for the 2013-2014 school year.
- Lisa DeTommaso was appointed Secretary to the Business Administrator/Board Secretary effective August 1.
- Resignations were accepted from Steven Van Bochoven (Network Administrator), Maria Sfondouris (Instructional Aide), and Jennifer Testa (Long-Term Replacement Teacher).
- Mentors were approved for new staff members.
- Teacher appointments were approved for Kristen Frohn (Gr. 2/WHS), Amy Kokoszka (Gr. 2/TBS), Arlene Schlosser (.5 Intervention/WHS), Paul Yunos (.4 Physical Education/Health/TBS and WHS), and Jaime Ericson (Long-Term Replacement Teacher/HBS)
- ♦ Bus driver appointments for 2013-2014 were approved.

Communications

- ♦ Amendments to Policy 5112 Entrance Age were rescinded to establish the entrance age for kindergarten as 5 years old on or before October 1 of the school year pursuant to NJSA 18A:38-6.
- ♦ The Board acknowledged the achievements of Jonathan Reed Hadley and Matthew Eugene Parrella, who have completed the requirements for their Eagle Scout Awards.
