Superintendent's Report

- Dr. Sargent requested approval to form an ad hoc committee for strategic planning.

- Finance/Facilities: Mr. Finn reported that the committee met on December 9, 2011; the meeting's main focus was Risk Assessment.
- ◆ Education/Technology: Mr. Livingston reported that the committee met on January 5. The need for more assistance with technology in the schools was discussed.
