Superintendent's Report

- Mindfulness Program Advisor Anthony Tumolo, along with several RMS staff members and eighth grade students, reported on the piloting of the Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) mentor meetings initiative at the middle school.
- The annual District and School HIB Grade Report was presented along with the monthly HIB report.

Finance/Facilities

- A resolution was accepted binding the district to purchase electric generation services through the Alliance for Competitive Energy Services (ACES).
- A resolution was approved for the sale of surplus property through GovDeals.
