Superintendent's Report

- Dr. DeFabiis congratulated RMS invention teams and their advisor, Betsy Freeman, for advancing to the STEAM Tank 2018 Finals.
- Dr. DeFabiis presented the quarterly discipline report.

Finance/Facilities

- Various appointments were approved for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Signatures were authorized for various 2018-2019 district accounts.
- Employee insurance benefits with AmeriHealth and Horizon Dental were renewed for the 2018-2019 school year.
