Superintendent's Report

Dr. Hart shared the district's Readington Ready Reopening Plan with the board and community. To view the presentation, please [click here](#). The plan will revise the school calendar making September 3 and 4 early dismissal days. It also identified A and B days for student in-person attendance. A revised school calendar will be submitted for board approval at the August 18 board meeting. Dr. Hart introduced Mr. James Belske who presented a hybrid learning demonstration.
