Superintendent's Report

Dr. Sargent reported on the April 22 announcement by the Obama Administration that Three Bridges School has received national recognition as a 2014 U.S. Department of Education Green Ribbon School. A Green Ribbon celebration was held at the school immediately preceding the Board of Education meeting. A national award ceremony will be held this summer in Washington, D.C.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ Camp Invention, a non-profit science camp, was approved to be held at HBS from 8/4/14 through 8/8/14.
- ◆ A resolution was accepted awarding the contract for Window Replacement Phase II at RMS to Panoramic Window and Door Systems, Inc.
- ◆ Preschool tuition and transportation rates were approved for the 2014-15 school year.
- ◆ Summer enrichment, music and sports camps rates were approved for the 2014-15 school year.

Education/Technology

- ◆ Two fundraisers were approved to benefit the Destination Imagination teams.
- ◆ Tuition contracts were approved for six staff members' children to attend Readington Township Schools for the 2014-15 school year.
- ◆ Three field trips were approved as follows: TBS Grade 1 students to the Readington Community Garden; Destination Imagination teams to the Global DI Finals in Knoxville, TN; and Life Skills students to the Special Olympics.
- ◆ The Summer Enrichment Program and the Sports Camp Program were approved for the 2014-2015 school year.
