## **Superintendent's Report**

- ◆ Dr. DeFabiis reported that the 2018-2019 school budget had been approved by the County Office.

- ◆ Enviroscapes Inc., as the lowest bidder, was awarded a contract for the RMS Detention Basin Retrofit.
- ◆ The 2018-2019 budget was approved for the 2018-2019 school year.
- ◆ Tuition rates were adopted for the 2018-2019 school year for Grades K-8 and Special Education students.
