Superintendent's Report

- ◆ Spotlight on WHS: Whitehouse School Principal Dr. Ann DeRosa and several WHS students presented an overview of the school's Character Education program for which they have been named a 2017 New Jersey School of Character.
- ◆ The public hearing on the 2017-2018 budget was held.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ The award of a contract to Aero Plumbing & Heating Co. was approved for bathroom renovations at Three Bridges School and Whitehouse School.
- ◆ A Shared Services Agreement with Tewksbury School District for Technology Support Services was approved for the 2017-2018 school year.
- ◆ A Shared Services Agreement with Branchburg Township School District for Transportation Services was approved for the 2017-2018 school year.
- ◆ A resolution was approved to adopt the 2017-2018 Budget.
- ◆ YMCA School Age Child Care Programs were approved for the 2017-2018 school year.

- ◆ Two seventh grade field trips were approved, one to the State Theater in New Brunswick and one to various hiking trails in Readington.

- ◆ One RMS fundraiser was approved for May 2017, an 8th grade Charity Kickball Tournament to benefit St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.
