August 28, 2018

The following information contains highlights from the August 28, 2018 Readington Board of Education meeting. For complete minutes, please check the district website on or about September 12, 2018.

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Jonathan Hart updated the board on the expected school enrollment for the start of school. In addition, reported that all schools were ready for opening day - September 6, 2018.

Finance/Facilities

- The Readington Middle School Detention Basin Retrofit Project change order resolution did not carry.
- The Readington Middle School Bathroom change orders were approved.
- The standard mileage rates between schools for the 2018-2019 school year were approved.

Education/Technology

- Language Arts Curriculum (Grades 1-3); Math Curriculum (Grades K-3/3 Honors); Dance Curriculum and Theater Curriculum were all approved.
- Novels for 6th, 7th and 8th grades were approved for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Destination Imagination fundraisers for the 2018-2019 school year at Holland Brook School were approved.

Personnel

- The resignations of Antoinette Boccuzzi (WHS Instructional Aide); Patricia Valeo (Bus Driver); Antoinette Riordan (RMS Clerical Aide) and Sarah Holland (TBS Instructional Aide) were accepted.
- Stipends were approved for additional teachers participating in the Summer Teacher Academy Program.
- Mentors for new teachers in the provisional teacher program were approved for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Approval was given for the Superintendent to hire personnel until September 11, 2018.
- The following appointments were approved: Lindsay Capone (RMS/LA Teacher); Jennifer Fisch (Bus Driver & RMS/Cafeteria Aide); Jean Fetzer (HBS/Cafeteria Aide); Diane Krasovec (RMS/Nurse) and Deborah Nazzaro (RMS/School Nurse).

Communications

- Four policies and three regulations were approved for first reading. One policy was approved for second reading and adopted.
- Policy 5512 was approved with one reading to have effective for September 1, 2018.
- Regulation 5512 was abolished.
