Superintendent's Report

- ◆ RMS Principal Sharon Moffat and RMS Assistant Principal Jonathan Moss made a presentation on the Chromebook Initiative at Readington Middle School.
- ◆ Stephen Foster, Chair of the Readington Environmental Commission, led a discussion concerning the water detention basin project at Readington Middle School.
- ◆ Dr. DeFabiis recognized WHS Principal Dr. Ann DeRosa and WHS Teacher Anthony Tumolo for being selected as members of a team that will judge other districts' Character Education programs.
- ◆ Dr. DeFabiis also recognized TBS Principal Kristen Higgins, who has been selected to serve on the NJ State Department of Education Teacher Leader Endorsement committee.
