Superintendent's Report

Spotlight on Readington Middle School: Staff and students presented an overview of new encore courses being offered this year at the middle school.

- ◆ A Professional Services Contract with SSP Architects was approved for bathroom renovations at TBS and WHS and for media center doors replacement at RMS.
- ◆ The annual Uniform State Memorandum of Agreement between Education and Law Enforcement Officials was approved for the 2016-2017 school year.

Education/Technology

- ◆ Two fundraisers were approved for RMS: Fun Pasta Products to benefit the Readington Athletic Booster Club and "Let Them Play" Change Collection to benefit the Tibet Women's Soccer Team.
- ◆ Ten novels were approved for eighth grade.
- ◆ A grant in the amount of \$500 was accepted for RMS from the NJ Association of School Librarians.
