### **Superintendent's Report**

**Spotlight on Readington Middle School:** Principal Sharon Moffat; Encore teachers Emily Bengels, Tracy Fitzgerald, Mark Lalumia, Ryan Newcamp, and Roseanne Panico; and students from RMS presented various art projects and musical performances.

### **Finance/Facilities**

- ◆ It was reported that the next Finance Committee budget meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 4 at 5:00 p.m.
- ◆ A grant in the amount of \$500 was accepted from Creative Management, Inc. and the ExxonMobil Fuels Marketing Educational Alliance to be used toward the math and/or science programs at HBS.
- ◆ The district's Long Range Facility Plan was amended to include the RMS roof and the RMS Life Skills classroom renovation projects.

### **Education/Technology**

- ◆ Various school fundraisers were approved to benefit the Destination Imagination teams, the RMS Library Media Center, 8th grade activities, the RMS Student Council and the Hero Campaign, and New Jersey Blood Services.
- ◆ A 6th grade field trip to the Math Museum and Wax Museum in New York City was approved.
