Superintendent's Report

Karen Tucker, Supervisor of Pupil Services, presented an overview of the district Harassment, Intimidation, and Bullying (HIB) policy and procedures.

Finance/Facilities

A Shared Services Security Agreement with the Township of Readington to provide security services to the end of the 2016-17 school year was approved.

Education/Technology

- ◆ Three RMS fundraisers and one TBS fundraiser were approved.
- ◆ A field trip to Old Turnpike School (Tewksbury) for the Battle of the Books competition was approved for RMS.
- ◆ A Home School Association mini grant in the amount of \$1,123 was accepted for HBS to purchase instrumental music supplies.
- ◆ The Special Education Extended School Year Program was approved for July 5—August 3, 2017.

Personnel

- ◆ Clubs and club advisors were approved for TBS and WHS.
- ◆ Gaye Villa, Assistant School Business Administrator/Board Secretary, was approved as the district Public Agency Compliance Officer for the remainder of the 2016-17 school year.
