Superintendent's Report

Dr. Jonathan Hart greeted the board and community. Karen Tucker, Supervisor of Pupil Services, presented the Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying (HIB) Self-Assessment Report

Finance/Facilities

- The IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) grant application and acceptance of funds in the total amount of \$365,024 were approved.
- The ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Act) grant application and acceptance of Title I & Title II funds in the total amount of \$82,064 were approved.
- The Title III Consortium portion of the ESSA grant application in the amount of \$12,834 with \$4,025 designated for Readington funds and the participating districts was approved.
- A Shared Services Security Agreement with the Township of Readington to provide security services for the 2018-2019 school year was approved.

Education/Technology

- Tuition agreements for Readington students to attend out of district programs for the 2018-2019 school year were approved.
- Level One Services from the New Jersey Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired for five Readington students were approved for the 2018-2019 school year.
- A donation of a drum set to be used at Holland Brook School from an anonymous donor was accepted.

Personnel

- Team leaders and coaches, as well as homework room, central detention and club advisors were approved for Readington Middle School for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Kevin Sanders and Paul Yunos were approved as RMS Athletic Coordinators for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Stipends were approved for teachers participating in the Summer Teacher Academy Program.
- The following appointment was approved: Kenneth Cubillas (Teacher/Music - Percussion Specialist).
- The resignations of Nicole Torpey (TBS Special Education Aide); Katherine Cataldi (RMS School Nurse); and Jennifer Smith (RMS LA Teacher) were accepted.

Communications

- Four policies and three regulations were approved for second reading and adopted. One policy was approved for first reading.
