Superintendent's Report

- ◆ Dr. Sargent presented the January through June 2015 Violence and Vandalism report.
- ◆ Karen Tucker, Supervisor of Pupil Services, reported on the Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying Self Assessment.

Finance/Facilities

The district's food service contract with Maschio's Food Services Inc. was approved. Student lunch price for the 2015-2016 school year will be \$2.70 (increase of \$0.10 from 2014-2015 school year).

- ◆ Fundraisers, a Bobcat Pumpkin Bash, and Bobcat Bingo Night were approved for Holland Brook School for the 2015-16 school year.
- ◆ A donation in the amount of \$283.29 from the Beacon Society was accepted to purchase library materials at RMS, and a donation of six iPad minis and cases from the HSA was accepted for TBS first grade.
- ◆ A grant in the amount of \$500 was accepted from the Wrigley Company Foundation National Wildlife Federation which will be used to expand recycling and waste reduction at RMS.
