Superintendent's Report/Presentations

No report: Dr. Sargent was in Washington, D.C. attending the Green Ribbon Award Ceremony for Three Bridges School with TBS Principal Kristen Higgins and two additional staff members.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ A motion to submit NCLB and IDEA grant applications and to accept said funds was approved.
- ◆ The district's food service contract with Maschio's Food Services Inc. was approved. Student lunch price will be \$2.60 for the 2014-15 school year.
- ◆ A grant in the amount of \$2,200 from Investors Bank was accepted to be used toward the purchase of a 3D printer for the Innovation and Design program at RMS.
- ◆ Title I Grant Funds in the amount of \$29,654 were accepted as a result of Whitehouse School being named a High-Performing Rewards School for the 2013-14 school year; the funds will be used in support of the school's Title I program and to sustain the high levels of academic achievement at WHS.

- ◆ Tuition agreements were approved for students attending out-of-district programs for the 2014-15 school year.
- ◆ Integrated preschool student contracts were approved for the 2014-15 school year.
