Superintendent's Report

Dr. Sargent reported on the 8th grade promotion ceremony held on Friday, June 19.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ Resolutions authorizing the award of contracts for professional and proprietary services and state vendors for the 2015-2016 school year were approved.
- ◆ The shared services agreement with Branchburg Township for transportation administration and bus maintenance was renewed for the 2015-2015 school year.
- ◆ A required lunch price increase was approved for the 2015-2016 school year.

Education/Technology

- ◆ Curricula, textbooks and instructional resources were approved for the 2015-2016 school year.
- ◆ HSA Mini Grants were accepted for HBS and RMS.
- ◆ A resolution establishing the Mark Cleere Memorial Scholarship Fund and awarding the first recipients of scholarships was approved.

- ◆ NCLB and IDEA grant applications were approved for submission.
