Superintendent's Report

Dr. Sargent delivered an update on district goals.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ The 2014-2015 Tax Levy Request was approved.
- ◆ The district's food service contract with Maschio's Food Services Inc. for the 2014-15 school year was approved.
- ◆ A \$500 donation from the Mason family was accepted for use in the TBS Sensory Garden.
- ◆ A motion to contract with Bollinger Insurance to offer 2014-15 voluntary student accident plans was approved.
- ◆ A bid for the construction of the Life Skills classroom was awarded to Salazar & Associates, Inc.

Education/Technology

- ◆ Curricula, textbooks and instructional resources were approved for the 2014-15 school year.
- ◆ A revised [2014-2015 school calendar](#) was approved.

Personnel

- ◆ Staff were approved for facilitating and participating in the 2014 Summer Teacher Academy program.
- ◆ The following resignations were accepted: Mengli Wang (Mandarin Teacher/RMS); Donald Thornton (District Facilities Manager); and Michelle Krynicky (Gr. 1 Teacher/WHS).
- ◆ The retirement of Carol Kroner (Kindergarten Teacher/WHS) was acknowledged.
- ◆ The appointments of the following new staff were approved: Chuan-Ying Yang (Mandarin Teacher/RMS); Jennifer Smits (Grade 1 Teacher/WHS); and Jessica Marczyk (Kindergarten Teacher).
- ◆ Staff were approved to facilitate the 2014 Summer Enrichment Program.
