



BOARD BRIEFS

MARCH 13, 2012

The first Board of Education meeting each month is a work session; the second is an action meeting. The following information contains highlights from the March 13, 2012 Readington Board of Education work session meeting. Superintendent's Report

- ◆ Representatives from Genesis Educational Services, Inc. presented their student information software, which has been recommended by the Technology Committee for use in our district. Members of the Technology Committee discussed their reasons for recommending the Genesis software.
- ◆ Superintendent Barbara Sargent provided an overview of the District's 2012-2013 Annual School Budget.

Committee Reports

- ◆ Education/Technology: Mr. Livingston reported on NCLB changes, scheduling articulation between Board representatives of Hunterdon Central's constituent districts, and a walk-through template being piloted by administrators.
- ◆ Personnel: The committee met on March 9 to discuss 2012-2013 positions, shared services with Tewksbury, and Superintendent evaluation.
- ◆ Communications: The Committee met to discuss policies relating to the Education/Technology Committee, acceptable use of computers, and pupil discipline. They also discussed participation of home-schooled students in the district's athletic program.
- ◆ Green: The committee met on March 8 to discuss an energy audit follow-up, lighting upgrades at Three Bridges School, a "Turn Off the Lights" program, and upcoming Earth Day programs.

Finance/Facilities

A service provider agreement with Genesis Educational Services, Inc., for the Genesis Student Information Software System was approved in the amount of \$28,500 for the 2012-2013 school year.

Unfinished Business

Mr. Livingston spoke about tenure reform legislation.

- ◆ Mr. Doran encouraged Board members to inform the community about the webcasting of Board meetings.
- ◆ The April 10, 2012 Board of Education meeting has been cancelled since it coincides with Spring Break.
