Superintendent's Report

- ◆ Spotlight on RMS: Principal Sharon Moffat and Assistant Principal Jonathan Moss presented highlights of interactive web-based educational tools used at the middle school.
- ◆ Mark Warner of Gabel Associates and Ryan Scerbo of DeCotiis, Fitzpatrick & Cole, LLP presented a summary of the district's Solar Initiative Evaluation Report.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ The April 28-May 11, 2016 bill list; the May 10, 2016 district travel schedule; and April 1-30, 2016 account transfers were approved.
- ◆ The Board accepted the recommendation of the Evaluation Team to select Ameresco/EZ Nergy under Proposal Option 1 as the successful respondent, and the Business Administrator was authorized to execute a Power Purchase Agreement with the successful respondent, subject to advice and counsel of the Board's Special Energy Counsel and Energy Consultant.
- ◆ The district's employee insurance benefits with AmeriHealth and Horizon Dental were approved for renewal for the 2016-2017 school year.
- ◆ Remaining motions were reviewed and will be voted on at the May 24, 2016 meeting.

Education/Technology

- ◆ A field trip for RMS theater students to present a play at TBS was approved.
- ◆ The non-resident tuition rate for tenured staff members' children to attend Readington schools was approved for the 2016-2017 school year.
- ◆ Remaining motions were reviewed and will be voted on at the May 24, 2016 meeting.

Personnel

- ◆ Tenured and non-tenured certificated staff members were appointed for the 2016-2017 school year in accordance with the RTEA agreement.
- ◆ Tenured and non-tenured administrators were appointed for the 2016-2017 school year in accordance with the RTAA agreement.
- ◆ Remaining motions were reviewed and will be voted on at the May 24, 2016 meeting.
