Superintendent's Report/Presentations

- ◆ Spotlight on Three Bridges School: Staff and students from TBS made a presentation on how technology is used in their school.
- ◆ Dr. Sargent presented an update on the two-tier transportation proposal for the 2015-2016 school year.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ Preschool tuition rates were approved for the 2015-2016 school year.
- ◆ The YMCA School Age Child Care Program was approved for the 2015-2016 school year.
- ◆ Summer session rates were approved for Summer Enrichment and Summer Sports Camps.
- ◆ A resolution was adopted to sell surplus property through GovDeals.
- ◆ Various appointments were approved for the 2015-2016 school year.

Education/Technology

- ◆ Professional development training for the Handwriting Without Tears program was approved for elementary level teachers during the May 22, 2015 Half-Curriculum Day.
- ◆ The following field trips were approved: Grade 3 to Summer Road Park; HBS Spanish students to TBS and WHS; Grade 8 to Liberty State Park and Science Center (alternate trip for students not going on the Washington, D.C. trip); and RMS Life Skills classes to Duke Farms.

Personnel

- ◆ The following resignations for retirement were accepted: Alfonsina Altomare (RMS French teacher) and Beverly Okulicz (WHS Special Education teacher).
- ◆ The following resignation was accepted: Liana Rozsa (RMS Assistant Principal).
- ◆ Steven Struble was appointed as a long-term replacement custodian.
- ◆ Staff members were appointed for the 2015-2016 school year.
- ◆ Staff members were approved for the district's Extended School Year Program.
