- ◆ Two candidates for the open seat on the Board of Education were interviewed.
- ◆ Pupil Services Supervisor Karen Tucker reported on new legislation concerning special education students' participation in school athletics.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ The Board awarded the contract for custodial services to Temco for a contract term of two years (July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015).
- ◆ The Board awarded the contract for renovations for full-day kindergarten at Whitehouse School and Three Bridges School to Charles Mann General Contracting, Inc.
- ◆ The Board awarded the contract for window replacement at Readington Middle School to Pottsgrove Glass Co., Inc.

- ◆ The Board accepted the Superintendent's recommendation to provide 2013-2014 renewal letters and employment contracts to district staff.
