Superintendent's Report

The 2016-2017 district retirees and Governor's Educator Award honorees were recognized.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ Various appointments were approved for the 2017-2018 school year.
- ◆ Employee insurance benefits with AmeriHealth and Horizon Dental were approved for renewal for the 2017-2018 school year.
- ◆ The food services contract with Maschio's Food Service was approved for renewal for the 2017-2018 school year.
- ◆ A required student lunch price increase from \$2.75 to \$2.85 for the 2017-2018 school year was approved.
- ◆ The schedule for requisition of taxes from Readington Township was approved for the 2017-2018 school year.
- ◆ Educational/medical professional services providers were approved for the 2017-2018 school year.

Personnel
