### **Superintendent's Report**

Kari McGann, Supervisor of Humanities, presented a review of the district's literacy initiatives.

### **Finance/Facilities**

- ◆ District appointments were approved for the 2013-2014 school year.
- ◆ A resolution to award contracts for professional services for the 2013-2014 school year was approved.
- ◆ The YMCA School Age Child Care Programs for the 2013-14 school year were approved.
- ◆ Consultants and their associated fees were approved for the 2013-14 school year.
- ◆ The Shared Services Agreement for Technology Support Services between the Readington Township Board of Education and the Tewksbury Township Board of Education was approved for the period July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2015.

### **Education/Technology**

- ◆ Annual pre-school tuition rates were approved.
- ◆ Seven staff members were approved to attend the Mickelson ExxonMobil Teachers Academy in New Orleans in July, at no cost to the district.
- ◆ A self-funded Summer Music Camp enrichment program was approved for the weeks of June 24 and July 8, 2013.
- ◆ Two RMS fundraisers were approved; one to benefit Starfish and the second to benefit Big Brothers/Big Sisters.

### **Personnel**

- ◆ The retirements of Dorothy Calkin (TBS Art Teacher) and Susan Reardon (RMS Social Studies Teacher) were acknowledged, effective June 30, 2013.
- ◆ The 2013-2014 Holiday Schedules were approved for Custodians/Maintenance, Secretaries, Administrators, and Technology Staff.
