Superintendent's Report

Dr. Hart announced that it is National Teacher Week and in our schools, we are celebrating Teacher Appreciation Day, National School Nurse's Day and School Bus Driver Appreciation Day. Dr. Hart thanked all our teachers, instructional aides, nurses, and bus drivers for their dedication to our students not just on these special days but every day. Dr. Hart shared a presentation on School Start Times. Dr. Hart mentioned that there is a possibility of revising the 2018-2019 Calendar to make June 20, 2019, an early dismissal day.
