Superintendent's Report

Focus on Three Bridges School: The speech therapists, enrichment teacher, special education teachers, and behaviorist presented information on how they support students.

Finance/Facilities

- ◆ The Annual Maintenance Budget Amount Worksheet and the Comprehensive Maintenance Plan Report for 2015-2016 were approved.
- ◆ Fiscal Year 2016 NCLB Title I Part A funds in the amount of \$54,716 and Title II Part A funds in the amount of \$24,556 were accepted.

Education/Technology

- ◆ K-8 Music, Grade 4 Honors Math, and Grade 4 Advanced Math curricula were adopted.
- ◆ The 2015-2016 NJ Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC) Statement of Assurance was approved for submission to the NJ Department of Education.
- ◆ The following fundraisers were approved: volleyball game (RMS); Barnes and Noble (RMS); Jump Rope for Heart (HBS); Destination Imagination Bake Sales.
- ◆ The following field trips were approved: Lost River Caverns for TBS and WHS Grade 3 students (replaces field trip to Sterling Mines); and Lily Yip Table Tennis Center/Hibachi Grill and Supreme Buffet for RMS Mandarin classes.
- ◆ A resolution authorizing the submission of a Sustainable Jersey for Schools Grant was approved.

- ◆ The following personnel appointments were approved: Helena Coelho, Instructional Aide (HBS); Michael Idenden, Technician (district); and Kirsli Spinks, Technician (district).
- ◆ Frank Garaffa was approved as a long-term leave replacement custodian.
- ◆ HBS Grade Level Leaders were approved for the 2015-2016 school year.
- ◆ WHS and HBS Club Advisors were approved for the 2015-2016 school year.
