Superintendent's Report

Dr. Hart recognized the following students for being awarded a partnership with the USDA for their FIG (Fresh Food From Indoor Gardens) Investigation: Braden Galloway, Andrew Leibowitz, Eddie Lou, and Christopher Serrao. Andrew Leibowitz was also recognized for being awarded attendance at the Character Leadership Camp for Academically Talented Students. Dr. Hart shared an update on the district's Strategic Planning process.
