TOVA FRIEDMAN

Survivor of the Holocaust

Tova Friedman miraculously survived Auschwitz with her mother at the age of 6 1/2. Her experience and that of her friends were published in, *Surviving Auschwitz*, edited by Milton J Niewusma. She appeared on TV and has a number of interviews on YouTube. Tova came to the U.S. at age 12. She received a B.A. in psychology from Brooklyn College, an M.A. in Black Literature from the City College of New York and a M.A. in Social Work from Rutgers University. She taught at Hebrew University and was the director of Jewish Family Services for over 20 years. Tova shares her story with students, at public & private schools, at colleges and places of worship, and prisons. Tova is married for 60 years, a mother of four children and a grandmother of 8 grandchildren.

Survivor of the Rwandan Genocide

Daniel Trust is the President and CEO of Daniel Trust Foundation, an award-winning youth development nonprofit organization that provides mentorship and financial support to disadvantaged students and their teachers in Bridgeport, CT and New York, NY. Daniel is a survivor of the Rwandan Genocide and he immigrated to the United States as a refugee at the age of 15. Daniel is a proud member of the LGBTQ community. As an international speaker, Daniel has spoken to thousands of people in Asia and at high schools, colleges, and conferences throughout the United States.
