Here is what you need to know:

When: Read-a-thon is **Friday, March 13th, 2020**

Time: 2:30 to 6:00 PM: (*snacks will be provided from 2:30 to 2:50 PM*)

Do I have to stay the whole time? **NO**, students do **NOT** need to attend the entire time

Where: RMS Library

Why: To facilitate a passion for reading while raising money for a local cause (St. Hubert's Animal Shelter)

Parent Pick-up: Students will need to be signed out by a parent from the library. No child will be allowed to wait outside the library to be picked-up.

Dinner Break: If your child is staying until 5:30 PM they can pre-order pizza at \$2.50 per slice. **Pizza must be pre-ordered and prepaid** See permission slip attached. Students can bring a "brown bag" dinner if they choose.

What students should bring:

- Something to read: novel, magazine, or any school appropriate reading material.
- Students may bring pillows, sleeping bags, camp chairs...any item to be comfy!
