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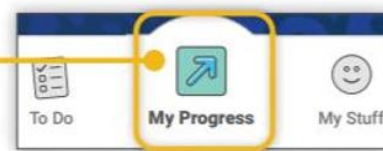
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i-Ready Diagnostic Results

Once your child has completed the i-Ready Diagnostic you can view their scale score by logging into their i-Ready account and viewing the **Completed Work** section in **My Progress**.

You and your student can monitor progress by clicking on **My Progress** in the bottom navigation bar.



On the **My Progress** page, you will be able to see Time-on-Task for Personalized Instruction and the total number of lessons passed this school year. Once you have entered the **Completed Work** section in **My Progress**, you will be able to see quiz scores for each lesson your child has completed as well as the scale score for the Diagnostic.

“The scale scores that result from the Diagnostic measure all students on the same scale so you can see which K-12 skills your student has mastered, regardless of their grade level. Student performance is measured on a scale of 100-800, with your student’s current score indicating the skills they have mastered up to that point in the school year and the skills they still need to work on moving forward. Scale scores help your student’s teacher determine their placement level. **However, scale scores alone do not tell the whole story of your student’s skill mastery.** -- [i-Ready Family Center-FAQ](#)
