### **Dinner Dance:**

#### ***Drop Off/ Pick Up***

  - Please pick up your student outside the Cafetorium
  - You will need to sign for student pick up; there will be tables set up outside the cafetorium (weather permitting- inside if not)
- Please make sure the bus loop outside the cafetorium remains clear for our bus return

### **Dorney:**

The class trip will be held at Dorney Park in Allentown, PA from 10 a.m.-5 p.m.

#### ***Pick up/Drop Off***

- Students will take their normal bus/parent drop off to school
- Students will be departing from school at 9 a.m.
- Pick up students from RMS at 5 p.m.
  - Your student will text you when we are departing the park
  - Please pick up your student outside the Cafetorium
  - You will need to sign for student pick up; there will be tables set up outside the cafetorium (weather permitting- inside if not)
