Important Dates and Times

The first day of school is Thursday, September 5th, 2019

Please be sure to print your child's schedule and send it with him/her on the first day of school.

School hours are 7:25am- 2:25pm. Students should arrive to school before 7:25am each day. The **morning** Homework Room is available in the Old Gym starting at 7:00am for students arriving early. **Homeroom begins at 7:35am**. There is no student supervision available before 7:00am. Students arriving to school between 7:00am and 7:20am should report to the Old Gym for morning homework room.

The hours for **after school** Homework Room are from 2:25pm to 4:00pm, Mondays through Thursdays. Homework Room will begin on Monday, September 16.

Back to School Night is Thursday, September 12th at 6:30 pm. Please mark your calendars... we hope to see you there!

<u>Attendance</u>

Regular and timely attendance is one of the most important keys to the academic success of every student. To start their day off well, and avoid being marked tardy, students should arrive by 7:25am. Families are encouraged to schedule appointments and vacations outside of school hours. Of course, when a child is sick, he/she should remain home until well enough to return to school.

If your child will be absent, please call the school attendance line, **534-3831**, and leave the child's name, grade, and reason for absence. Do not email or leave a voice mail for individual teachers regarding your child's attendance. When returning to school from an absence, please submit a note. If a doctor visit has been made, a note from the physician will verify the absence.

Lockers

All students will receive a locker. All students are asked to purchase their own combination padlocks for their lockers. Students should practice their combination before the start of school and bring this lock on the first day of school. Dimensions of sixth and seventh grade lockers are approximately 11" (w) x 12" (d) x 60" (h).



This is the type of lock required.

Eighth graders will be assigned "red" lockers in the 500 wing. The inside dimensions of 8th grade lockers are approximately 12" (w) \times 11" (d) \times 32" (h). It is helpful to avoid purchasing 'oversized' notebooks or backpacks, as they will not fit properly inside lockers.
