Dear Readington Middle School Parents/Guardians:

As we move into the colder weather months, the threat of emergency school closure due to weather becomes more pronounced. The Readington Board of Education has built into the school calendar two days to be used for emergency school closings as needed. If school is closed due to an emergency, days will be made up using the snow contingency days in the following order: March 18, 2024 and May 28, 2024. Both days are now regular school days as we used two Snow Contingency dates.

If we need to close for a third day, this day would result in a Virtual Learning Day for Readington Middle School. This is due to the fact that there are 181 school days for students. **Only the third day due to an emergency closure would result in a virtual learning day.** If the district schools are closed due to snow or other emergencies beyond the third day, they will be deducted from spring break and/or added to the end of the year.

We hope we don't have to use our Virtual Learning Plan, but if we do, we are ready. We will be using our early dismissal bell schedule on this day. Students will be required to log into their computers for all of their classes throughout the day through Google Meet. All teachers will have a Google Meet link on their Google Classroom. A break will be built in for students during their academic support class time.
