<b>Asthma, Epinephrine, Seizure, &amp; Diabetes Plans</b> (MD Treatment Plan for care at school) <i>Students at middle school level are strongly encouraged to be independent and to self-carry and to be approved for self administer. *</i>	<b>Wednesday, Sept. 8, 2021</b>	Any student diagnosed with asthma, diabetes, a seizure disorder or anaphylactic allergies
<b>Medication (RX/OTC) Administration Form*</b> * POLICY regarding OTC meds - your own doctor, PA or NP must complete the form	<b>Wednesday, Sept. 8, 2021</b> First Day of School*  *or anytime during the year as changes occur	Any student who requires medication at school (includes Tylenol, Advil, seasonal allergy meds, ADHD meds, etc.)

*\*Doctor and parent must sign approval for self administration/carry on forms*
