iPhone

As the 2007 holiday shopping heats up, so does the New iPod Line. The new line comes with the new Shuffle, Nano, Classic, Touch, and the coveted iPhone. Here's the scoop on the latest iPods: First up is the redesigned iPod Shuffle, which has the same sport clip but comes in five different colors, which are Pastel Blue, Silver, Lavender, Pastel Green, and Red. They hold 240 songs and are about \$80 each.

Next on the list is the brand new iPod Nano, which has been redesigned to a 2 inch screen and is nearly 5 inches tall. It has also been redesigned to feature movies and TV shows, more photos and games, and, of course, more music. They come in five different colors, Pastel Blue, Silver, Dark Grey, Pastel Green, and Red {only available in 8GB}. The 4GB version costs \$150 and the 8GB versions start at \$200. These iPods can hold from 1000-2000 songs.

Now the iPod Classic is an **awesome** iPod. It looks like a regular iPod; it has a click wheel, a 2^{1/2} inch screen, comes in the normal iPod colors of white and black, and can fit in your pocket. But something about this iPod is different than all the rest, and that is the **80-160GB** of storage! That's right, these iPods hold that much, which is equivalent to 20,000-40,000 songs, 25,000 photos, and 100-200 hours of video! The Classic's price is roughly \$250 for the 80GB version and about \$350 for the 160GB version.

I strongly recommend this next iPod to everyone the iPod Touch. It is the leader of the iPods next to the iPhone. I only say this because if you look at the picture above, you'll realize that the Touch and the iPhone are VERY similar. They are about the same size, they both have multi-touch screens that are 3.5 inches high, same settings, but the Touch isn't a phone. That's the whole Touch description. The Touch and iPhone would be the same thing if the Touch was a phone. The Touch comes in one color, black, holds 8-16GB, and is \$300 for the 8GB version, and \$400 for the 16GB version.

Last but definitely not least on the list is the iPhone. It is not a true iPod, but is classified as one, as it is a phone as well. But who in their right minds would not even think of buying this? It comes with many beautiful features: calling, text messaging, photo taking, video playing, voicemail, Internet connection, and Wi-Fi connections to games, a global clock, a calculator, and much more, and all at your fingertips. They are \$400 and come in black only.


