

Levels of Service for Readington Township Schools

Level 1: Differentiated Instruction and Exploratory Experiences

Occurs in the classroom for all students and is directed by the classroom teacher. Examples: Individualized reading or writing conferences, projects adjusted to accommodate individual learning styles, creative and critical thinking skills and tools, field trips, guest speakers

Grades Pre K-8: Occurs in each classroom

Level 2: School-Wide Enrichment

All students are encouraged to participate. Examples: After-school clubs, lunch time enrichment groups, Sunshine Math, Spelling or Geography Bees, Science Fair, NJ Makers Day

Grades K-5: Push in whole class lessons, voluntary pull out groups, and after-school clubs

Grades 6-8: Lunch time and after-school clubs

Level 3: Academic Grade Level Extension

Specific criteria must be met in order to qualify for services.

Kindergarten and Grade 1: ELA and Math Extension

Grade 2: Math Extension

Grade 3: Honors Math and Math Extension

Grades 4 & 5: Honors Math

Grades 6-8: Advanced and Honors Math

Honors Language Arts

ELA and Math Extension consists of once a week pull out services.

Level 4: Gifted and Talented Services

Specific and rigorous criteria must be met in order to qualify for services.
Classes are led by the GT teacher.

Grades 2-5: Pull out services 3 times a week

Grades 6-8: Pull out services 2 to 3 times a week
