Social Studies – Interview an adult member of your family. Come up with at least ten questions that show the differences between life today and life 30-40 years ago. Examples include: What kind of technology did you have in school or in your house? Afterwards, write a paragraph relating the past to the present.

Language Arts – Choose an advertisement from a newspaper, magazine, or online. Take a piece of paper and fold it so you have 3 columns and label them "Item," "Fact," and "Opinion." Find at least five advertised items and list them in the "Item" column. Record facts and opinions in the appropriate columns.

Science – If you could choose one planet to spend a day on, which one would it be? Research that planet and explain how your body would have to change in order to adapt to its climate. Write a two paragraph essay to explain.

Math – Get ready to problem solve! In the table below are strategies used for solving problems. Create two number stories that can be solved using two different techniques from the chart below. Make sure to example how you would use the technique to solve the problem and how you found your answer.
