Social Studies – Choose a president to research. Create a timeline illustrating ten major events that happened while he was in office.

Language Arts – Imagine that this year your class will have a class pet. Write a letter to your teacher persuading him/her to choose your favorite pet. Anticipate all of the standard objections and overcome them in your letter.

Science – Animals live in all different places for different reasons. Research an animal that lives in the plains, forest, jungle, river, desert, or snow and ice. Print out or draw a picture of the animal. Write a one paragraph essay explaining where the animal lives and why. Is there anything specific about their body or behavior that helps them to survive in their environment?

Math – With a member of your family, divide a deck of cards equally between the both of you. Each card is worth its own value with Aces, =1, Jacks=11, Queens=12, and Kings=13. Each member flips over two cards and multiplies the two numbers together. The player with the highest product wins and collects all four cards. The game continues until one player is out of cards
