Math - More or Less

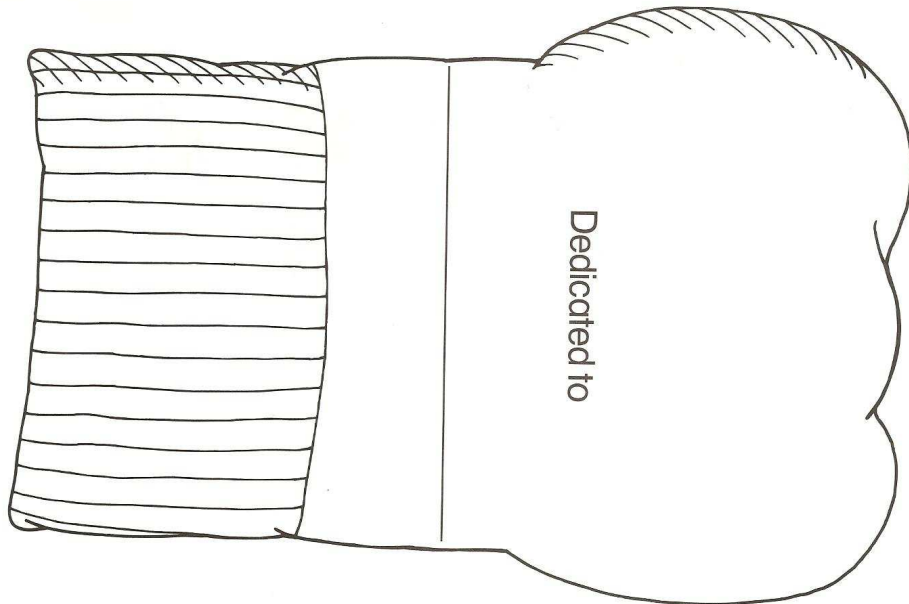
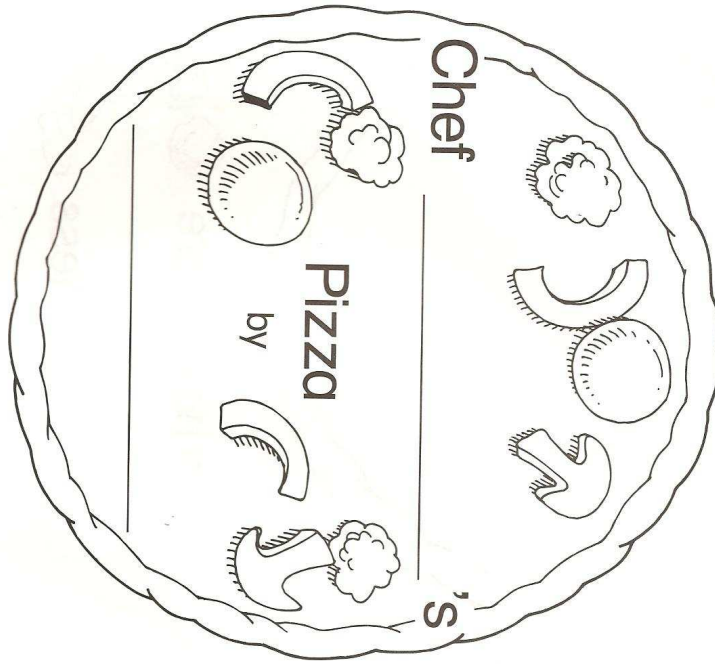

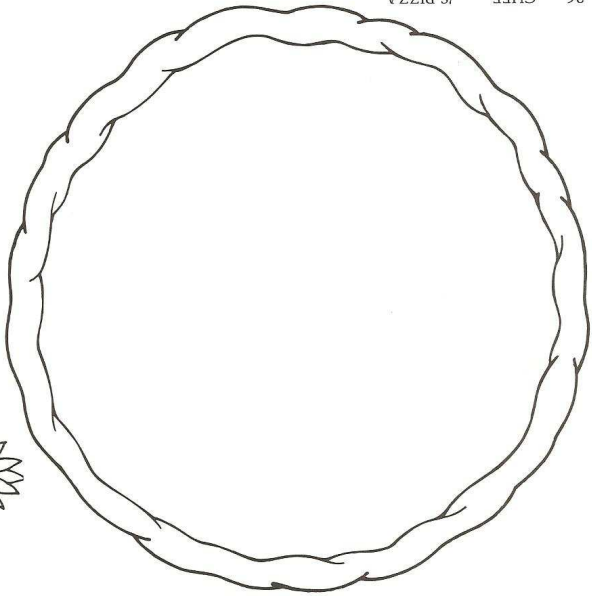
Science - Separating Liquids

Tell your child that you are going to do an experiment. You are going to mix water, oil and syrup. Allow your child to make a prediction about the liquids. Will they mix or separate? Help your scientist pour equal amounts of oil, water, and syrup into a large glass. In the end, explain to your child that the syrup, the densest liquid, sank to the bottom. The water sat in the middle and the oil rose to the top. As a bonus, try dropping some solids into the liquid such as a penny, a lego and a wood chip. Discuss what happens.

Social Studies - Hand in Hand

Help your child trace around the outside of one hand. Inside the hand outline, have your child draw a picture to show one special thing he/she likes. Have them write their name on their paper. Discuss with your child if they know anyone who likes the same things they like.





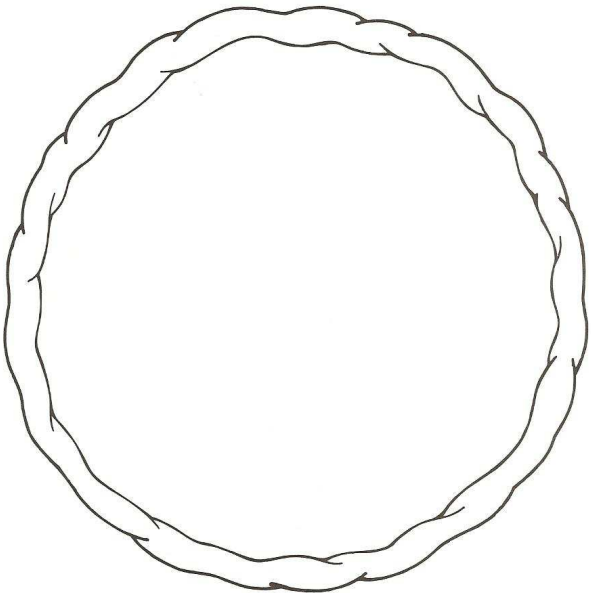
