<u>Day 5</u>

Language Arts - School Day Charades
Using the picture cards, your child will play charades. Have your child color (if they want to) and cut out the picture cards. Place pictures face down on a surface. Allow your child to pick a card from the stack and look at it. No one else should look at the card. He or she will act out-without speaking-the activity on the card. You will try to guess what the child is doing. Take turns picking a card and acting out the activity pictured.

Math - Patterns

Gather some like materials such as silverware, matchbox cars, crayons, legos, coins, etc. Remind your child what a pattern is. Show your child a pattern with the materials you assembled. You might use a fork, a fork, and a spoon. Have your child continue the pattern. Now, let your child create a pattern and you continue it. Take turns with your child. Your child may want to record some of his/her patterns on paper to share with others.

Science - Dressing for the Season
Discuss with your child what season it is. See if they can
name all four seasons. Have your child draw a picture of the
kinds of clothes that would be appropriate for the season
we're in right now.

Social Studies - Buildings, Buildings Everywhere
Brainstorm with your child different buildings you might see
in town (houses, grocery store, library, firehouse, school,
Polar Cub, etc. Discuss with your child if the building is a
place to shop, a place to live, or a place to get help.
