## Language Arts - Main Idea

Remind your child that every story has a main idea. The main idea is what the story is mostly about. Read a story to your child or use the Tumblebooks website, <a href="http://www.nypl.org/">http://www.nypl.org/</a>. First click on "Books and Materials" at the top, next click on Tumblebooks, then click on "Storybooks", and now choose a story your child would like to listen to. After your child has heard the story discuss with her/him what they think the main idea of this story was. He/she can draw a picture and write a sentence about the main idea of this story.

Using different shapes draw a picture. Try to include as many shapes as you can.


Science - Using Your Senses

## Social Studies - Town Bingo

Call out a kind of place, and your child will find one of those places and place a penny on it. If you say, a place to get help, your child could cover the police station, the fire station, or the school with a penny. Only cover one at a time. To win, your child needs to cover four pictures in a row. Bingo!!
