PSYCHOLOGY

Psychology is the study of the human mind and behavior. In this course, students will be introduced to the brain, mental wellness, memory, and popular theories about how we we think, learn, and act.

Design problems will be solved using various visual art mediums, leaving room for a student's own personal ideas and artistic style. In this hands-on class, you will master broadcast video basics and learn to work as a crew as you take on the role(s) of your choice: producer, director, writer, camera operator, audio engineer, video editor, designer, or on-air reporter.

We will work in the studio <u>and</u> through field reporting across our schools to develop RMS and District broadcast news programs, commercials, and public service announcements.

We'll also partner with experts from broadcast television, and tour and train at their studio too!



Yoga This course will cover both concepts of the practice of Yoga, as well work on breathing techniques to destress. Students will have the opportunity to learn the different muscle groups that are used for each pose or routine. They will also be able to create their own routine!







Concert Band (6th Grade Band)
