I would like to take the opportunity to reach out to our community members to make everyone aware of our protocols for our Hunterdon Central on campus events. If you are planning to attend any of our fall sporting events please see the protocols for each event below.

Face coverings (Gaiters Prohibited), and Social Distancing is required at all times during the event.

As you are aware, we are under strict guidelines based on the governor's executive order. Our events will be limited in capacity. Therefore we will have to limit the number of tickets for all spectators including the parents of our teams, band, cheerleading, dance, staff, students, and visiting teams.

Therefore all football games this fall will be a private event for the families of the participants only. There will be no outside spectators allowed at the games.

Boys/Girls Soccer, Field Hockey, Girls Tennis.

We will be requiring an electronic ticket at all home games this year. Tickets will be posted on the website at least a day in advance of the game. Please be sure to follow the procedure for registering for a ticket.

All tickets are free of charge but you will need to register and provide the ticket upon entry.

Pre-event

- Facilities will be setup prior to teams arriving at site.
- Social distancing signs will be visible and each field will have a sanitizing station
- Sanitizing stations will be available for both home and away players/coaches
- Bleachers will be clearly marked for proper social distancing

Participants

- Will be required to social distance while on the sidelines
- Will be required to wear masks unless they are in the field of play
- Will be asked to utilize the sanitizing stations when exiting the field of play
- Must provide own water bottle during games. (Refills will be available)
- Locker rooms will not be available during events. Restrooms will be available for limited use
- Will be screened upon arrival to our campus

Coaches/Event Staff

- Coaches/staff must wear a mask during the game at all times
- Coaches/staff are asked to utilize sanitizing stations throughout the duration of the event when necessary
- Will be asked to maintain social distancing guidelines with players, coaches, and officials
- Responsible for ensuring social distancing guidelines are being followed by their athletes and spectators
- Responsible for ensuring masks are being worn by players, staff and spectators

Parents/Spectators

- Must wear a mask while on our campus at all times with the exception of eating or drinking
- Must follow the social distancing guidelines and remain 6ft apart at all times
- Sanitizing stations will be available at each field location.
- Will be limited to 500 person capacity
- Gathering before an event is strictly prohibited on campus

Tickets

- All spectators must have an electronic ticket for entry
- Information on how to obtain tickets is in the above message under ticket information

Bleachers

- Home/Away Bleachers will be clearly marked with Tape
- Please abide by the markings and sit in those areas
- We ask that no spectators stand along the fence
