

READINGTON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION VACANCY

The Readington Township Board of Education is seeking a township resident to fill a seat which was recently vacated. Interested parties should send a letter of interest and resume to Jason Bohm, Business Administrator/Board Secretary, c/o Readington Township Board of Education, P.O. Box 807, Whitehouse Station, NJ 08889 or jbohm@readington.k12.nj.us. The letter should include qualifications and a brief description of interest in the position. The deadline for applications is Friday, February 9, 2024 by 10:00 a.m.. The Board will interview candidates on February 13, 2024, starting at approximately 6:00 p.m., after which an appointment will be made to fill the seat for a one-year term, expiring in January 2025.

The legal requirements to become a member of a local board of education in New Jersey include the following:

- Hold citizenship and one year's residency in the school district
- Have no direct or indirect contract with, or claim against, the Board
- Not hold office as mayor or member of the municipal governing body
- Be registered to vote and not be disqualified as a voter under N.J.S.A 19:4-1

The Board anticipates having four (4) vacancies to fill through the November election process, three vacancies covering 3 years and one vacancy covering 2 years.
