## **Minutes**

- 1. Remote Instruction Updates
  - a. Revised Closure Plan: Updated to meet the new checklist and criteria required by the DOE.
  - b. Close out procedures and calendar (as of today)
    - i. 5/22 will be online learning day
    - ii. June 1-5 will be teacher closeout days
    - iii. 6/19 will be pick-up/drop off day in afternoon
    - iv. 6/22 teacher closeout day and full day of pick-up/drop off for students
  - c. Graduation and other celebratory ceremonies: as of 5/13, we are now allowed to have a drive-thru graduation or wave parade. Options are being considered and will be discussed with Mrs. Moffat and Chief Greco.
- 2. Advanced/Honors Math Proposed Change
  - a. Discussed delaying start of Advanced Math to Sixth Grade
    - i. Students would have a stronger foundation of math skills
    - ii. More accurate identification of qualified students later in their academic careers (i.e. 6th grade as opposed to 4th)
  - b. This would be a gradual transition over the next two years
  - c. Honors would continue as-is
- 3. Chromebooks Next Year
  - a. Same procedure as last year, "Insurance/Safety Package" \$25 fee
  - b. Language in agreement to inform students and parents of filtering software that will monitor for troubling internet searches
  - c. Maintain one accidental damage per year
- 4. Summer Professional Development
  - a. Summer Teacher Academy will be virtual in July
    - i. Jully will be all tech sessions (15) to prepare in the event of future remote learning

- ii. August Teacher Academy (23) is TBD
- 5. Summer Programs (ESY, Rec, and Summer Enrichment)
  - a. ESY is expected to be virtual
  - b. Summer Enrichment has a lot of interest, TBD if it will run
  - c. TBD if Rec can run. Expectation is that the school building will remain closed for the summer
