1. 2019-20 Capital Projects -

a. Vestibules – The Committee reviewed the status of this project.

- b. The TBS condensate tank ordered in July is expected to be received October 15. This is a custom-made tank which was expected to take time to receive. Both boilers can operate while the condensate tank is being replaced.
- c. Maintenance Projects
 - i. TBS parking lot The French drain has been installed and this project is complete.

2. 2020-21 Capital Projects

- a. HBS gymnasium The floor will be tested for mercury levels during teacher convention week. If the test results are positive, the plan is for the floor to be replaced during the summer 2020. The risk level of exposure is low since the testing area will be sealed after testing. Once the floor is tested, the air quality will be tested to ensure proper air quality is maintained.
- b. Summer 2020 capital projects/Security 3-year plan Tabled until final list is completed
- c. Long Range Facilities Plan Scott Mihalick, SSP Architects will attend this meeting planned for the next Committee meeting.
