1. School Alliance Insurance Fund (SAIF) Renewal - Lee Nestle (President, CBIZ Insurance Services) presenting

General Liability Insurance discussion regarding 7.9% increase in premiums due to cost of cyber liability coverage and events throughout the country. We're in year 2 of a 3-year commitment.

## **2. 2021-2022 Capital Projects**

- HBS roofing project Progress on schedule, moving along well. Student areas completed first in case of supply chain issues. Pleased with our architect.
- o RMS bleachers replacement Old bleachers have been removed. New bleachers to be installed in Sept.
- Other maintenance/IT projects including flooring work, painting stairwells and sidewalk repairs at WHS, patched wall at HBS, painted music room at TBS, lockers painted at RMS, several trees removed, painting board office hallways

## 3. Grants

- Securing Our Childrens' Future Bond Act-\$78,551 Legislature approved project involving security film on windows.
- Emergency Connectivity Fund Potential value of \$164,350 To ensure students have ability to learn in remote setting if students need to work from home on their chromebook to continue coursework.
- ESEA amounts vary due to enrollment fluctuations

Breakfast will be available to students when they enter building. Machios continues to experience labor shortages. Currently have 6 employees, approximately 2-3 short.
