1. 2019-20 Capital Projects

- a. The Committee reviewed the progress of the District wide vestibule project.
- b. Maintenance Projects Various maintenance projects have been completed at each school including painting, carpet/tile replacement, sidewalk repairs, and light fixture replacement.
 - i. TBS parking lot two quotes were reviewed by the committee to mitigate a drainage issue. The committee requested other options be researched. There is no recommendation currently.

3. Lead Testing / Policy 7425

The Committee reviewed a letter required to be sent to parents concerning the school's lead testing of drinking water on June 29, 2019. Four fixtures failed the test were in the kitchen prep areas at WHS, TBS, and HBS. Remedial measures have already occurred which consisted of disconnecting each fixture. Two fixtures will be removed permanently. Two fixtures will be replaced and then retested. The complete test results will be posted to the District website.

4. Shared Services / Class III officer

The Committee reviewed the shared services agreement related the school security officers. The Committee recommends approval of the agreement.
