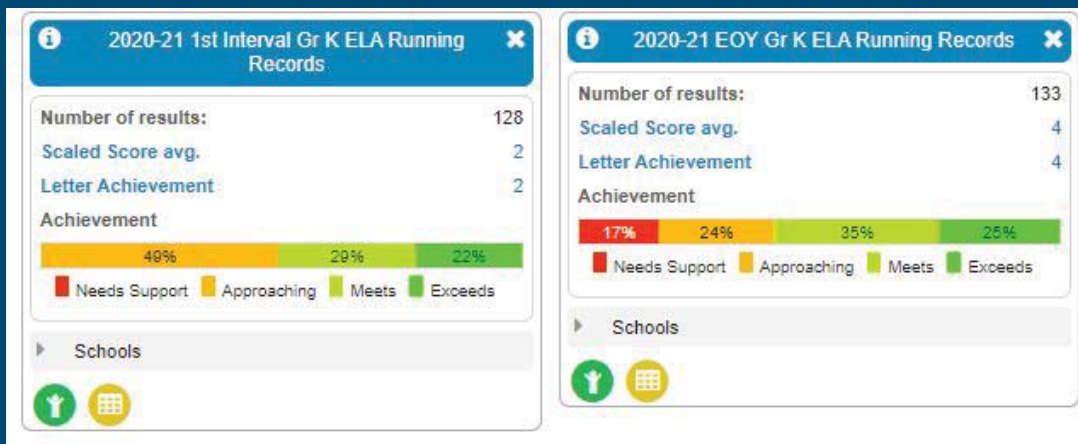
The Impact of the Past Year

 - This is the starting point for our work this year.
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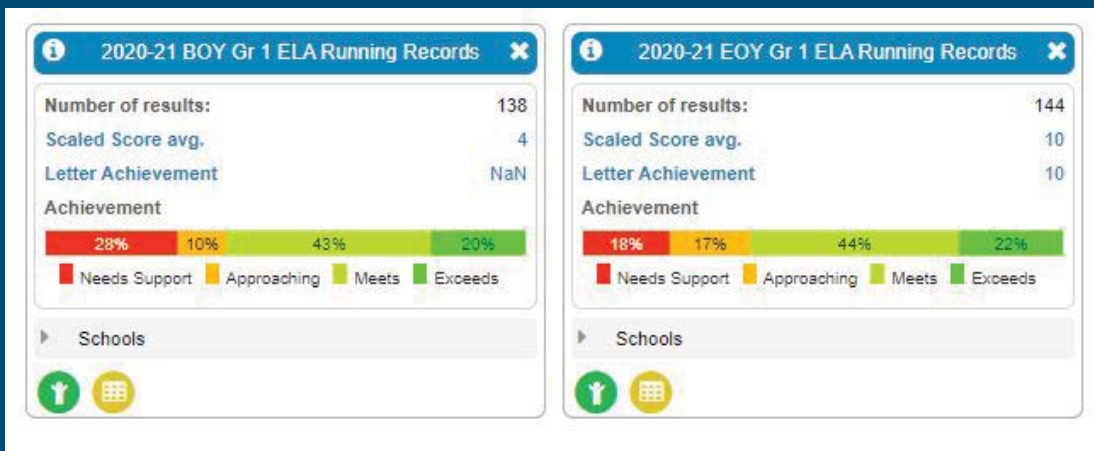

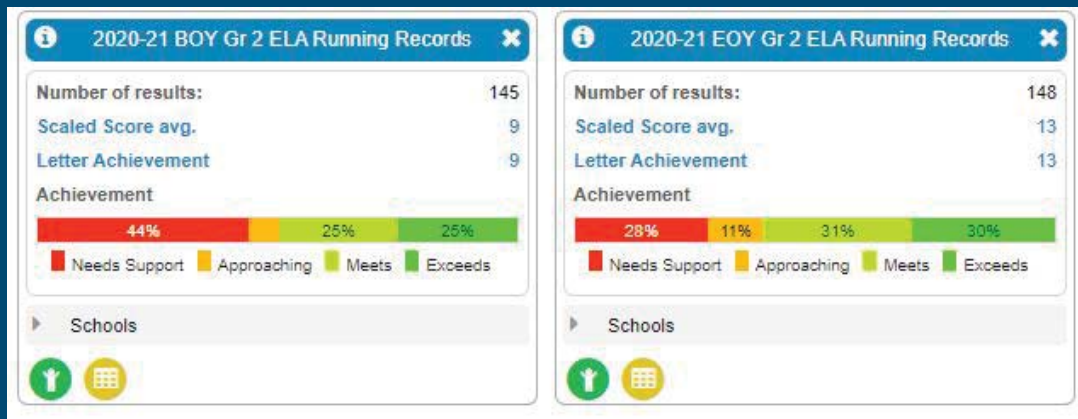

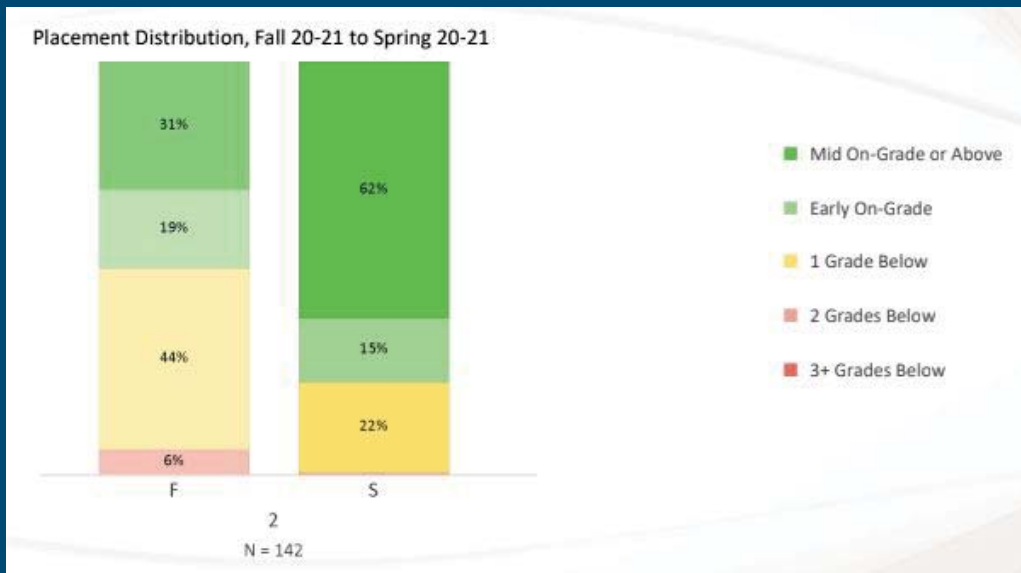
ELA: Last Year's 1st Grade



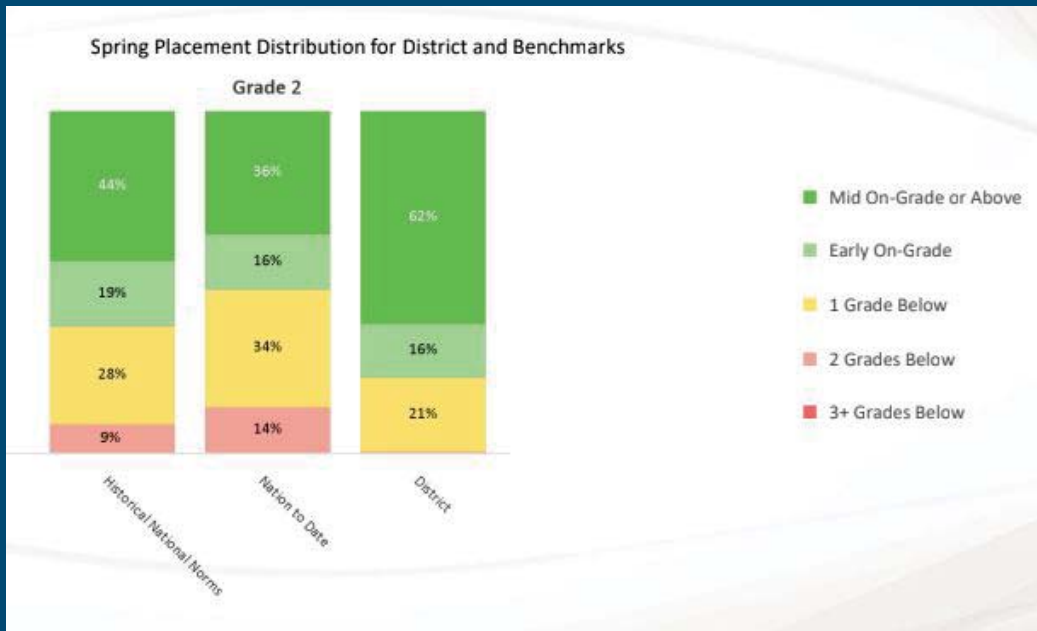
ELA: Last Year's 2nd Grade

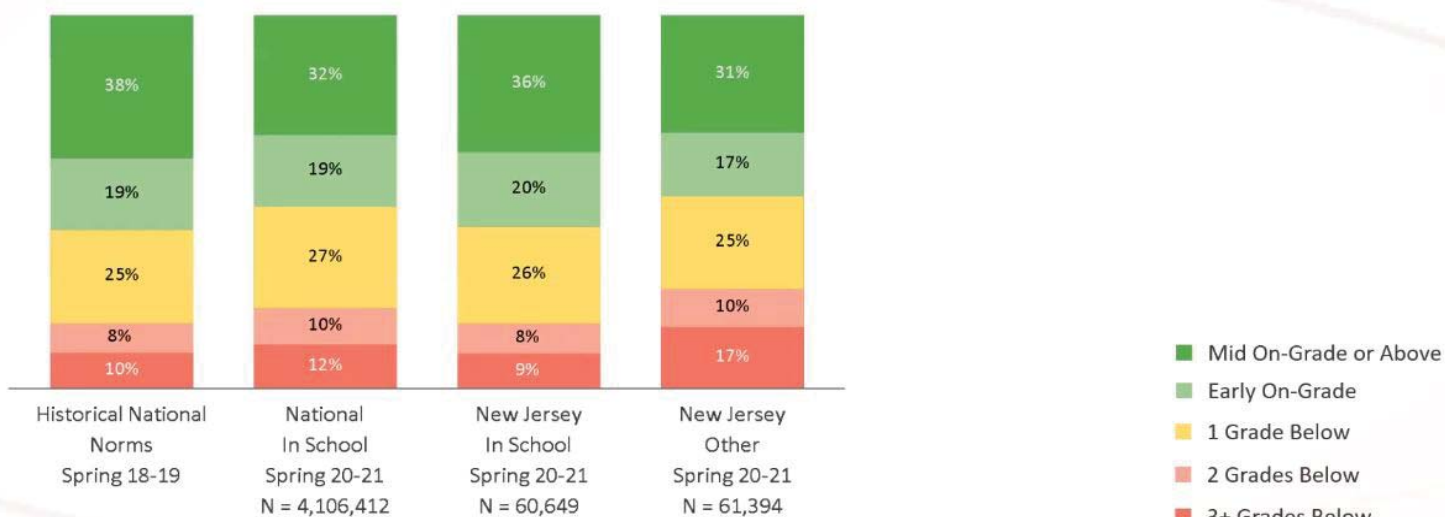

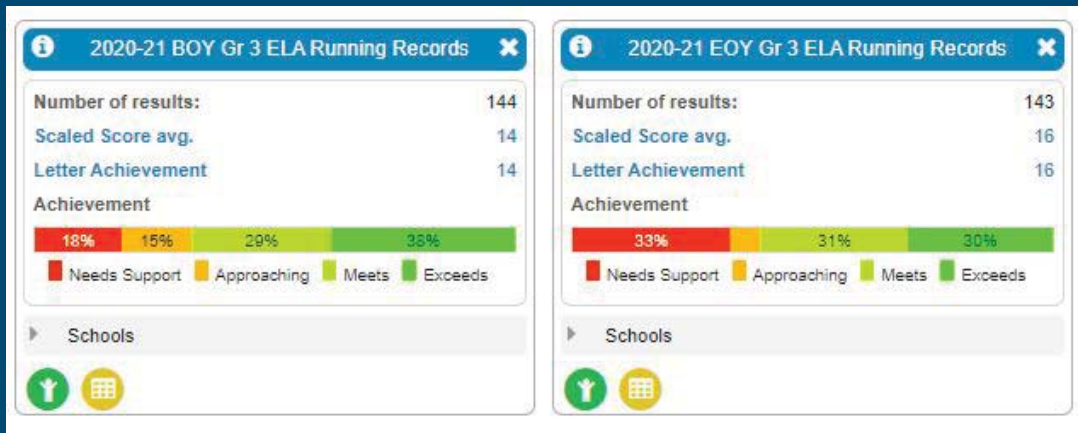

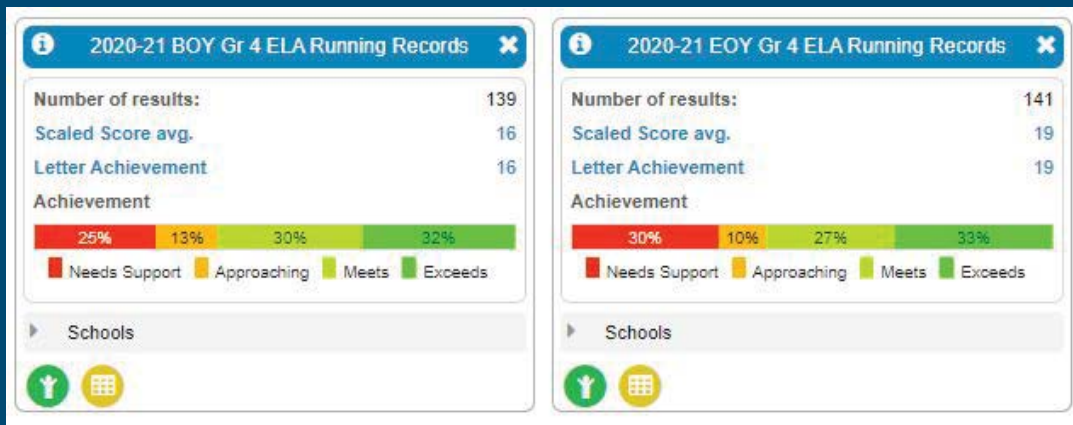
National Norms and New Jersey Placement Distribution as of 06-27



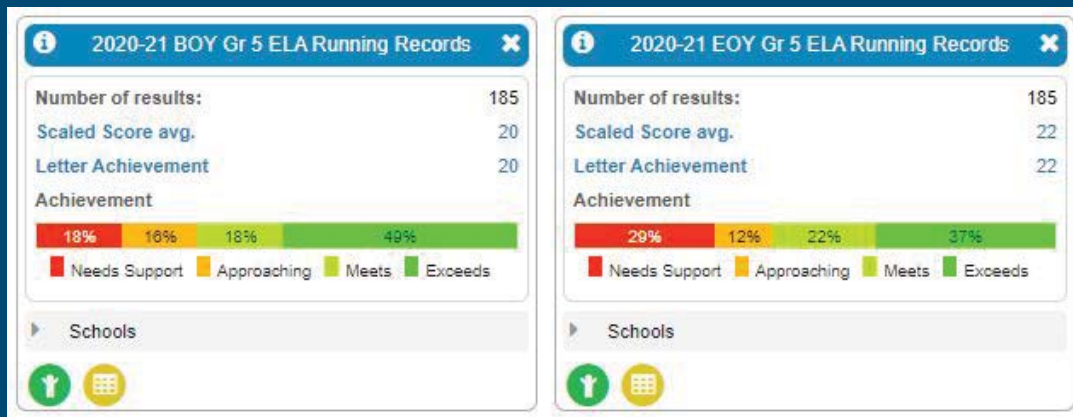

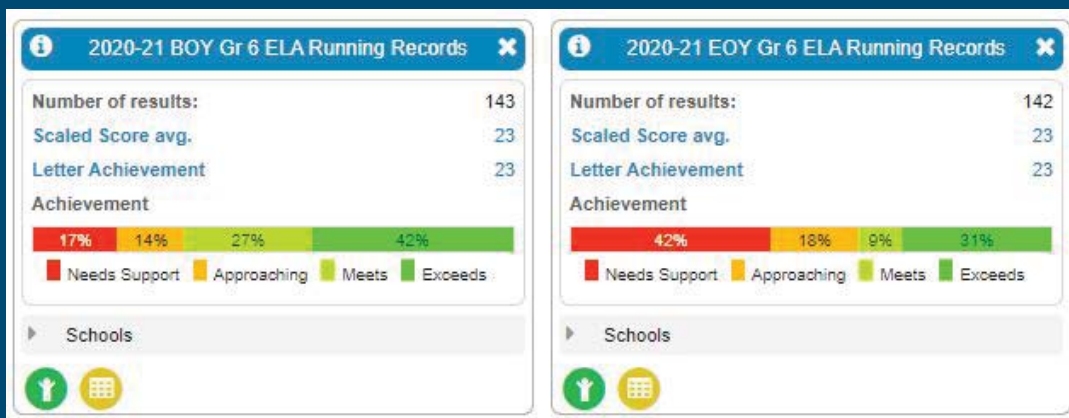

2 Grades Below

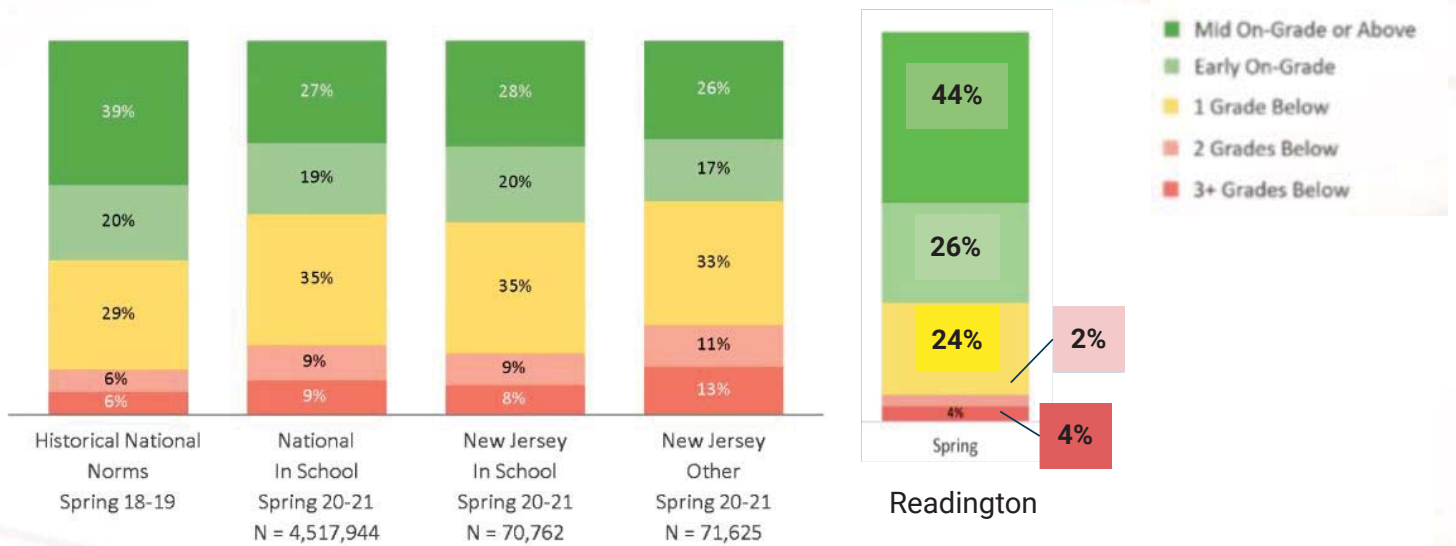
Students placed two years below grade level.

Students placed three or more years below grade level.

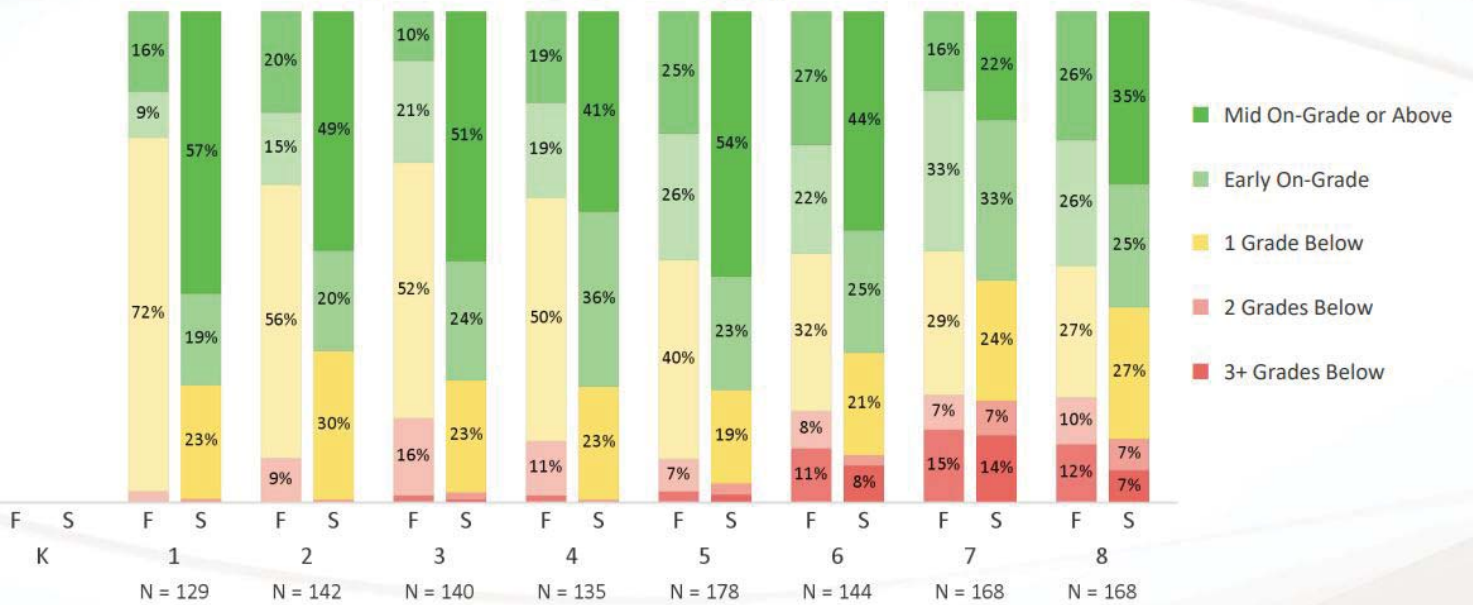

National Norms and New Jersey Placement Distribution as of 06-27



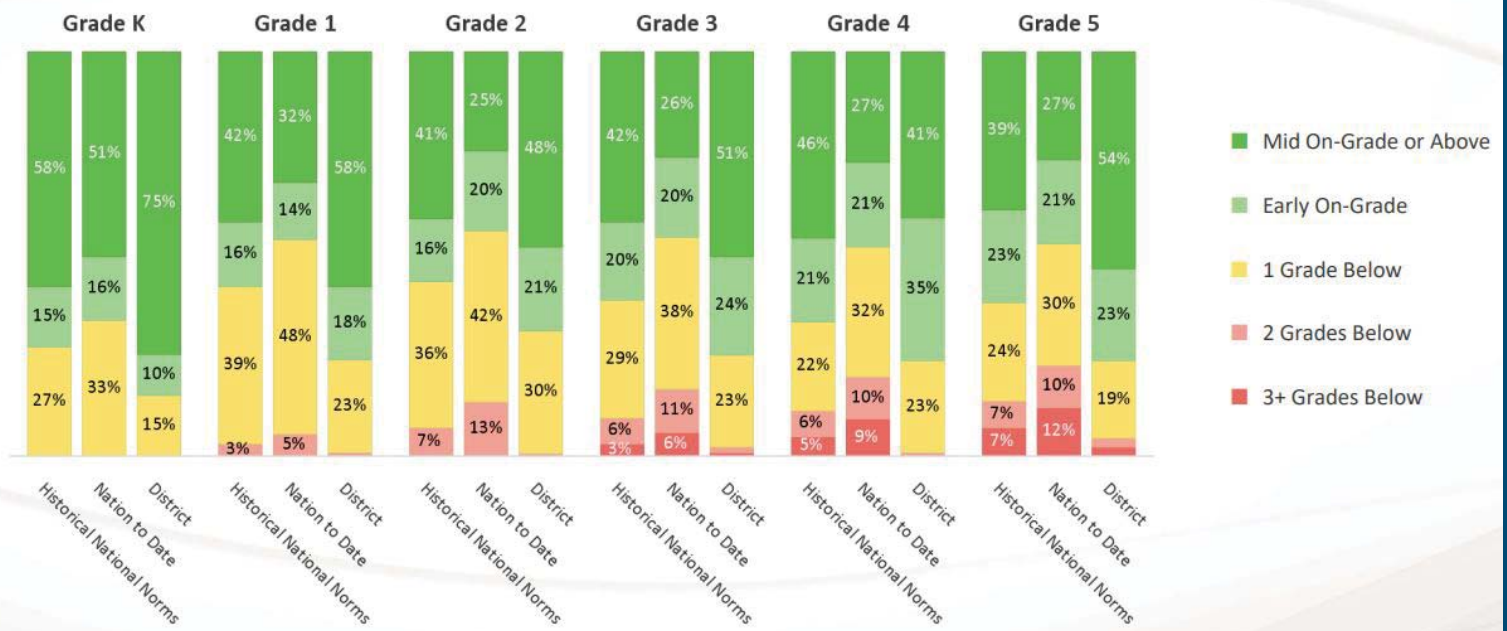
Math i-Ready Achievement Results

Placement Distribution, Fall 20-21 to Spring 20-21



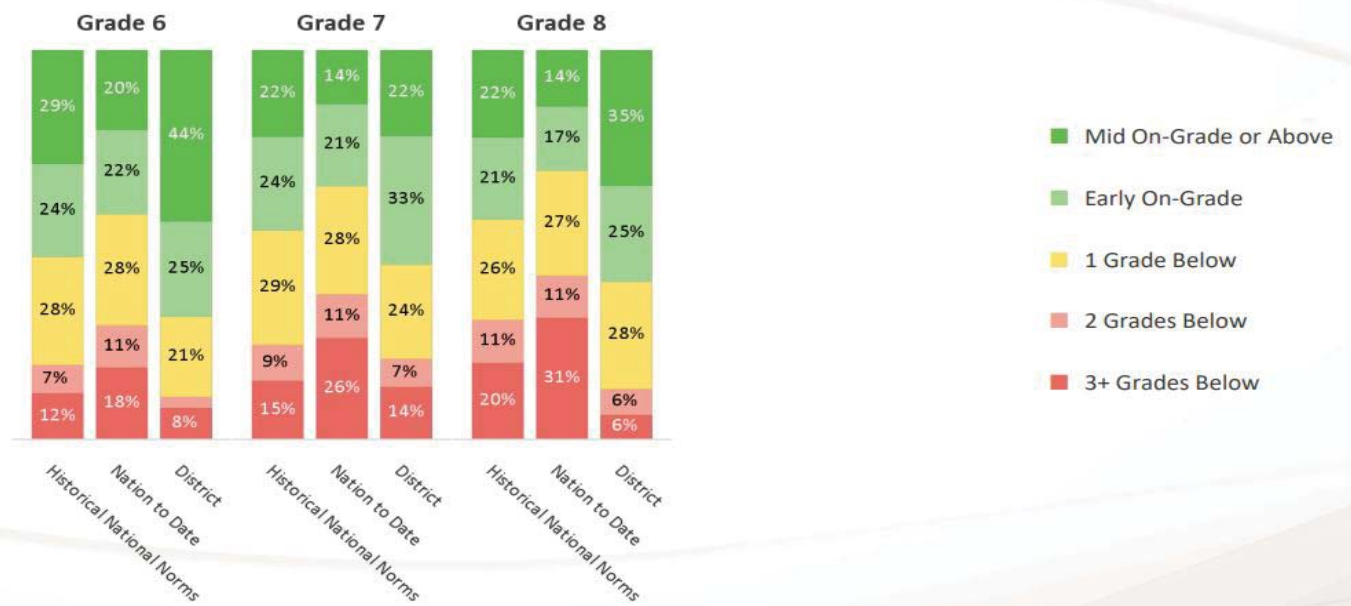

Ongoing Support

- Summer Learning Acceleration was a virtual one on one instructional program was highly successful.
- Additional iReady training from consultants during in-service days.
 - Use of data analysis to design small group instruction.
- Resources for how to address prerequisite skills while still moving forward with grade level content.
- Students at RMS are using i-Ready math online instruction twice a week during academic support and are receiving additional virtual tutoring.
- i-Ready Reading personalized learning for targeted intervention and special ed students grades K-5.
- Virtual office hours/homework help and tutoring for students on quarantine are available as needed.
- After School Learning Acceleration for Math and Reading began in early November.

Subject	Number of Students Assessed in Grades 3-8	% of students scoring in the At Target or Advanced range
Language Arts Literacy	13	80%
Mathematics	12	75%
Science	4	50%

ACCESS for ELL

- Measures language development of students identified as English Language Learners
- Students are assessed in the areas of Reading, Writing, listening and Speaking
- Six Proficiency Levels
- Proficiency score is comprised of: 35% Reading + 35% Writing + 15% Listening + 15% Speaking
- During the 2020-2021 **25 students** were assessed
