The New Jersey Administrative Code 6A:26-6.4 educational facilities planning standard requires that preschool classrooms are 950 square feet, or at minimum 750 square feet of direct instructional space. Five of the district's Preschool Expansion Aide ("PEA") funded classes offsite through a partnership agreement are less than 950 square feet, or minimum of 750 square feet of direct instruction space.

2. Describe what the school district intends to accomplish through the waiver that is currently prevented or disallowed by the existing rule(s).

Readington Township School District is requesting that the above preschool classrooms be approved for a facilities standard waiver for our full day state-funded PEA program.

3. Describe why a waiver is necessary to accomplish the desired or measurable result(s).

The educational facilities expansion waiver for state-funded PEA classroom space is necessary to provide the Readington Township School District preschool students with a full day program in the above classrooms that are less than the square feet per code.

- 4. Describe how the proposed waiver meets the following three criteria, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:5-1.3(a):
 - The spirit and intent of N.J.S.A. 18A, applicable Federal laws and regulations, and N.J.A.C. 6A are served by granting the waiver;
 - The provision of a thorough and efficient education to the school district's students is not compromised as a result of the waiver; and
 - There will be no risk to student health, safety or civil rights by granting the waiver.

The spirit and intent of N.J.S.A. 18A and N.J.A.C. 6A is served by granting the waiver a preschool classroom that is less than the requirement of 950 square feet, or 750 square feet of direct instruction space. The Readington Township School District believes that the provision of a thorough and efficient education to Readington Township School District preschool students would not be compromised by a lack of square footage in the classrooms listed above. The Readington Township School District does not believe that the request for a facilities waiver would present any risk to the health, safety or civil rights of the preschool students in the classrooms.

5. Describe the process, including solicitation of input and public comment, employed to inform the community, parents, district board of education members, administrators and staff during the proposal's development.

The Readington Township School District parents and community members will be provided this information on November 12, 2024, at its public Board of Education meeting.

The Readington Township Board of Education will adopt a resolution supporting the proposed facilities waiver for preschool classrooms at its November 12, 2024 public Board of Education meeting.
